As part of the APMA's Connected Vehicle Working Group, over 10 individual member companies have come together to build a prototype Connected Vehicle that is able to demonstrate a number of interactive and connected features, some of which include Early Warning alcohol detection, in-vehicle connectivity, advanced notification of approaching emergency services vehicles, gesture recognition for driver input/control, vehicle-infrastructure interface, and an operating system that integrates these features and more into a single user interface. The result is a driver console that is 3-4 years ahead of what is in vehicles today.


